
The picture below shows a rectangle that is 4 inches long and 6 inches wide. The area is expressed by $6 \cdot 4 = 24$.



1. **Draw a picture** that shows why multiplying 6 times 4 equals 24 inches squares.

2. Explain the meaning of multiplication in the equation $6 \cdot 4 = 24$.
